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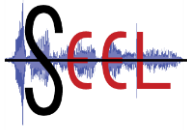

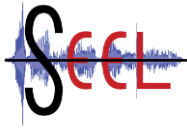

The other possible way is to use sound databases which are bonuses for some other kind of software, e. g. Pinnacle Studio or Prometheus ActiveBoard Studio.
